PROTECTING CHILDREN & PARENTAL RIGHTS!

BILL: Senate Bill 266

AUTHOR: Senator Mike Crider

SPONSOR: Representative Tony Cook

SUBJECT: Parents are responsible for raising children – not the government! Senate Bill 266 would give the government **unprecedented control** over all children in Indiana – **beginning at birth!** SB 266 orders state government to create a plan to track all children beginning at birth for social, emotional and mental health issues. The result would be **to label** potentially tens of thousands of children – beginning at birth – as not being normal and in need of social, emotional and mental health services and treatment. SB 266 also attempts to deceive parents and taxpayers by stating parental consent is required before: 1) a child can be subjected to a mental health survey, assessment, evaluation, etc., or 2) referred for or receive mental health services or treatment, or 3) before confidential information in a child's school file can be released. Unfortunately, the reality is that if any of these three things occur **without parental consent**, the parents can **only** complain to the Department of Education who can decide to **do nothing** to the school that violated parental rights. Language giving parents the right to sue the school was **stripped from the bill**. More information on SB 266 can be found under the download section of our website at www.advanceamerica.com.

STATUS: Senate Bill 266 passed the Senate on February 26, 2019 by a vote of 29-20 and now awaits action in the House of Representatives. To see how your Senator voted, go to the download section at www.AdvanceAmerica.com.

BILL: House Bill 1211

SUBJECT: House Bill 1211 would ban dismemberment abortions in the second trimester or later unless there is a serious health risk to the mother. This procedure was called barbaric during a hearing on House Bill 1211.

SUBJECT: Once again there is an attempt in the General Assembly to pass hate crime legislation. Senate Bill 12 was amended in the Senate so that **all individuals** who are victims of a crime would be treated **the same**. This is in line with current Indiana law.

STATUS: Senate Bill 12 passed the Senate on February 21, 2019 by a vote of 39-10 and now awaits action in the House of Representatives. To see how your Senator voted, go to the download section of www.AdvanceAmerica.com.

PROTECTING CHRISTIAN SCHOOLS!

SUBJECT: Christian schools are presently free in Indiana to operate according to the Bible. Some members of the General Assembly want to take this freedom away. On February 21, 2019 Representative Dan Forestal offered **Amendment #41 to House Bill 1001**. This Amendment would have **forced Christian schools** to hire teachers regardless of their sexual orientation or gender identity. The Amendment would also **force Christian schools** to admit students regardless of their sexual orientation, gender identity or religion. The Amendment was defeated 30-62. There will no doubt be other efforts to harm the freedom Christian schools now have in Indiana. By the way, if the government can tell a Christian school how to operate, they can tell a **church** as well!
