PROTECTING CHILDREN & PARENTAL RIGHTS - A HUGE OPPORTUNITY!

BILL: House Bill 1004

AUTHOR: Representative Wendy McNamara

SPONSOR: Senator Jeff Raatz

SUBJECT: Parents are responsible for raising their children and not the government! Senator Dennis Kruse offered an amendment to HB 1004 in the Senate Education Committee on April 3 to protect **over 1,000,000 children in the public schools!** Senator Kruse's Amendment would: 1) **protect all children** in the public schools from being subjected to a mental health screening, assessment, evaluation, or mental health services without prior written informed parental consent; 2) **protect children** from being inappropriately **labeled** as "mentally ill" or "not normal" and 3) **protect children in Christian and homeschools** because those who oppose Senator Kruse's Amendment to protect children in the public schools, also want to require all Christian and homeschool children to **undergo** mental health screenings and assessments too!
STATUS: HB 1004 with the Kruse Amendment in it passed the State Senate on 4/11/19 by a vote of 31-17 and now goes back to the House of Representatives.

ACTION: If you support protecting the children of Indiana, then contact your State Representative with the following message: "Please vote YES to CONCUR with the Senate version of HB 1004 to protect the children and parental rights."

PROTECTING CHILDREN & PARENTAL RIGHTS!

BILL: Senate Bill 266

SPONSOR: Representative Tony Cook

SUBJECT: Senate Bill 266 would give the government **unprecedented** control over all children in Indiana - **beginning at birth!** More

STATUS: SB 266 passed the Senate 29-20 on 2/26/19. Fortunately, the bill did not get a hearing in the House of Representatives. We will work to make sure SB 266 does not get added to another bill.

ABORTION!

BILL: House Bill 1211

SPONSOR: Senator Liz Brown

SUBJECT: House Bill 1211 would ban dismemberment abortions in the second trimester or later unless there is a serious health risk to the mother. This procedure was called barbaric during a hearing on House Bill 1211.

STATUS: House Bill 1211 passed the House of Representatives on 2/21/19 by a vote of 71-25 and 38-10 on 4/2/19 in the Senate. The bill now goes to the Governor.

HATE CRIMES!

BILL: Senate Bill 198

SPONSOR: Representatives Jim Pressel and Greg Steuerwald

SUBJECT: Once again there was an attempt in the General Assembly to pass hate crime legislation. Rep. Greg Steuerwald amended Senate Bill 198 to state that all individuals who are victims of a crime would be treated the same. This is in line with current Indiana law.

STATUS: SB 198 passed the House on 3/26/19 by a vote of 57-39 and was returned to the Senate. The Senate concurred with the House version on 4/2/19 by a vote of 34-14. Governor Holcomb signed the bill on 4/3/19.

PROTECTING CHRISTIAN SCHOOLS!

SUBJECT: Christian schools are presently free in Indiana to operate according to the Bible. Some members of the General Assembly want to take this freedom away. On February 21, 2019 Representative Dan Forestal offered **Amendment #41 to House Bill 1001**. This Amendment would have **forced Christian schools** to hire teachers regardless of their sexual orientation or gender identity. The Amendment would also **force Christian schools** to admit students regardless of their sexual orientation, gender identity or religion. The Amendment was defeated 30-62. There will no doubt be other efforts to harm the freedom Christian schools now have in Indiana. By the way, if the government can tell a Christian school how to operate, they can tell a **church** as well!

STATUS: To see how your Representative voted on Amendment #41 to harm the freedom Christian schools now have, go to the download section of www.AdvanceAmerica.com.

ACTION: If you believe that Christian schools should **continue to be free** to operate without government control, contact your Senator and Representative with the following message: "Please vote against any amendment or any bill that would harm the current freedom Christian schools now have to operate including the right to hire their own teachers and staff and to admit students according to Biblical guidelines." PROTECTING CHURCHES FROM GOVERNMENT CONTROL AND TAXATION!

SUBJECT: Churches in Indiana are **currently free** to operate their various ministries **without** government control. Churches are of course required to meet fire codes and sanitation requirements. But the government should **not** be able to tell a church **who** they can hire, **what** they can teach and **how** they operate! This includes **all** of the ministries of the church including: Vacation Bible School, day camp, Sunday school, Christian school, etc. Unfortunately, some legislators want to **take away** this freedom churches have enjoyed for generations! **Advance America** will continue to **lead** the effort at the State House to protect churches from government control and taxation!
