2. Fill out the form with your name and the name of your child. Make a copy of the form so you will have one for the school and one for your records.
3. Take one of the completed forms to your child's school and put a notation on your copy of the form with the date that you took the form to the school and who you gave it to.

If the school violates the provisions in the Parental Non-Consent Form, Liberty Counsel will provide legal assistance to your family at NO CHARGE!
