

Protecting Girls in the Public Schools

On Tuesday, May 24, 2022, the **House of** Representatives voted 67 to 28 to override the veto by Governor Holcomb of House Bill 1041.

Then the **State Senate** also voted to **override** the Governor's veto by a vote of 32 to15.

This vote by the House and Senate was a **victory** for common sense and a victory to protect girls in the public schools.

House Bill 1041 will now protect airls in the public schools **beginning in kindergarten** by:

- Keeping biological boys from participating in girls' sports!
- Helping keep biological boys out of girls' locker rooms in the public schools!
- Helping keep biological boys out of girls' restrooms in the public schools!


